The annual Social Stratification Research Seminar will be taking place on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> September 2018 at Clare College (Memorial Court), University of Cambridge.

- **Call for papers:** Proposals for papers for presentation are invited from any area in the broad remit of research into social stratification and social inequality. The 2018 meeting will mark 50 years of annual meetings run by this seminar group. In recognition, the 2018 meeting will include some sessions on the theme of how social stratification (and research on social stratification) has evolved through this period. Submissions of papers that address this theme are particularly welcomed, though other proposals are also welcome. We do not anticipate limiting the number of delegates attending, but we do expect to have to enforce an upper limit on the number of paper presentations that we can accommodate.
- If you would like to present a paper, **please send a title and short description of your paper (at least 100 words) to Paul Lambert by 14<sup>th</sup> June 2018 <<u>paul.lambert@stirling.ac.uk</u>>. Confirmation of papers for presentation will be made by 21<sup>st</sup> June 2018. Paper proposals received after the deadline will only be accommodated if there is space in the schedule. A provisional programme of papers will be published at <<u>www.camsis.stir.ac.uk/stratif/</u>>.**
- **Call for delegates:** The seminar group welcomes interested delegates including those who are not presenting a paper. Noting the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the meeting, we particularly welcome attendance from long-standing participants in the seminar group! Although non-presenting delegates need not confirm attendance until near the conference date, for the smooth running of the meeting please notify the conference organiser of your attendance at the earliest opportunity.

Final booking deadline:	27 August 201

Papers submitted by the deadline will be reviewed by the organisers in consultation with other regular meeting attendees if necessary. If the meeting is oversubscribed with paper proposals, priority will go to strong papers in the area of social stratification research and to submissions from delegates who will attend for the whole of the meeting and who have a track record of participation in the seminar group.

#### Seminar arrangements:

The seminar venue is the Bennett room within Memorial Court (off Queens Road), Clare College, Cambridge. The venue is around 600m from the centre of Cambridge (around 30 minute walk from the rail station).

The conference fee includes coffee/tea/biscuits at breaks, a light lunch provided at the venue, and standard guest facilities such as wifi. A conference dinner will be organised for the evening of  $6^{th}$  Sept. at a venue to be confirmed. To be included in the conference dinner, please indicate this on the booking form.

A number of participants will gather on the evening of Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> Sept for informal drinks/dinner, to which all delegates are welcome.

Travel and accommodation is left to delegates' own arrangements. Several delegates from the meeting are likely to stay in accommodation at Clare College (Memorial court), for which rooms may be booked online: <<u>https://clareconferencing.com/bed-breakfast-cambridge/</u>> (meeting code to be available from organiser). Other venues close to Cambridge city centre, however, are also likely to be plausible options.
