The 2020 version of the Social Stratification Research Seminar is planned for 26-28 August 2020 in online only format. A practice/registration session will run on the afternoon of 26 August, and presentation and discussion sessions will take place throughout the day on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> August (0900-1730 British Summer Time). A full schedule of papers and discussion slots will be circulated to delegates and presenters shortly before the meeting.

We originally hoped to have a face-to-face meeting on these dates but due to ongoing restrictions we now plan to run the seminar in online only format. Many papers have already been accepted for online presentation, however we do have capacity to accept a few more at time of writing, so we have an extended paper submission deadline for papers on any area of social stratification research. Late offers for additional papers for presentation during the meeting can be submitted by completing the proforma below and returning it by email no later than 11<sup>th</sup> August 2020. The organisers will aim to respond to submissions no later than 14<sup>th</sup> August. In normal circumstances we will ask that paper presenters prepare a recording of their paper approx. 20-25mins in length, to be supplied to the conference organisers no later than 24<sup>th</sup> August. These will be posted within the conference webinar area where slots for discussion and for viewing recordings will be built into the daily schedule. When necessary, presenters can alternatively give their paper live to the conference's webinar.
